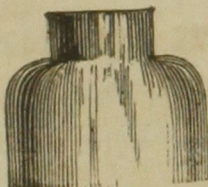
“P. L.” means “Patent Lip,” that is square, flat on top.



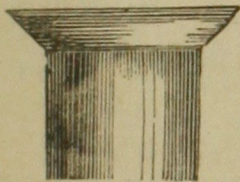
“Castor Oil or Ring,” means a finish such as is generally used on Castor or Cod Liver Oils.



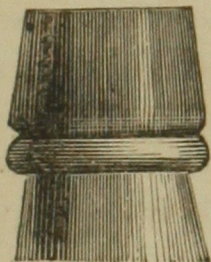
“Double Ring” means a ring such as on Citrate of Magnesia.



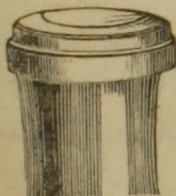
“Blow Over” means ground off without lip.



“Prescription Lip” style of lip used on all of our prescriptions.




“Wine Finish,” means lip used on Brandy or Wine Bottles.

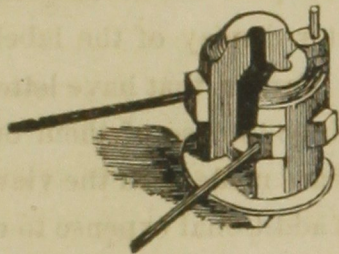
We have an open policy, covering shipments to all points, at as low rates as can be secured here, and include the premium in your regular merchandise account. Please say "INSURE," in all cases where you want the goods covered by us.

Parties ordering goods from us for the first time, will please send satisfactory references, as we send our price-list to many, of whose commercial responsibility we are ignorant, and whose orders are sometimes delayed until we can make inquiries through the regular commercial agencies.

No goods sent C. O. D. Freights by express are very expensive, and in case of non-acceptance by the purchaser, entail considerable loss to us to have returned.

NEW MOULDS.

Directions for Ordering.



In ordering moulds, select a bottle as near as possible to the one you want, giving directions for any changes or variations to be made in the new mould. A wooden model is more desirable, as you can show us exactly what you wish. Be particular to show how you wish it lettered—if a monogram is wanted, an idea of what will please you, will be acceptable, as tastes in this matter widely differ.

As graduates vary greatly in measure, we suggest the use of one, that has the measurement cut on it, instead of pressed.—We find the English the most accurate and use them to ascertain if bottles hold correct amounts.

Prices of moulds vary with amount of work expended on them. Can be furnished at an expense from ten to twenty-five dollars—for sizes ranging from half-ounce to one quart.

We call attention to the new line of PHILADELPHIA OVALS, which are very popular, the pattern has many admirers—an advantage of making a better display of the label, is one of the chief points in its favor. Parties that have lettered plates for French Square, can continue the use of them on the Philadelphia Oval, as our moulds are made with the view of accomodating the changes without additional expense to our customers.

We can stopper all ware on the list, and can make in Flint, Green, Blue, Amber or Opaque for special orders. Estimates made, and special quotations given for quantities.

When ordering, please state if Flint or Green Glass is wanted and if stoppered ware is desired. Name the style of stopper wanted.

ORDERS FOR SUMMER STOCK.

As our fires are out in summer, it is desirable to have your orders for what goods you may require for the summer months made up before we stop work. If possible, send them in not later than the month of May.

S H I P P I N G .

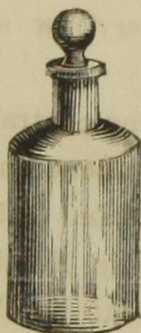
Always send shipping directions, at the same time leaving it to our judgment (when you have no contract) to send by cheapest route, as competition for freight makes rates very low at times.

Baltimore enjoys many advantages in shipping, being centrally located with numerous lines of steamships to southern and eastern ports. The two main trunk lines, Baltimore and Ohio and Pennsylvania Central carry goods to any point in North, West and Southwest at liberal rates. Special rates can be obtained on car-load lots.

Most manufacturers have their factories off in places that require transshipment of goods. *All* of our furnaces are within the city limits, and we ship *direct* from the factory to depots, thus saving one and very often two handlings.

Bills of Lading show rates of freight at which goods have been shipped. We are not responsible for overcharges, shortage or condition of packages when received. We ship all goods in merchantable condition and our *responsibility ceases*, when the transportation companies sign receipts. Present your Bills of Lading and make your claims upon them for any overcharges, missing packages or unusual breakage.
