




To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, Brooks D. Fuerst, a citizen of the United States, and residing at Toledo, in the county of Lucas and State of Ohio, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for a Bottle, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawing, forming a part thereof.

In the drawing:

Fig. 1 is a side elevational view of a bottle showing my design.

Fig. 2 is an end elevational view thereof.

Fig. 3 is a sectional view taken along the line III—III of Fig. 1.

Fig. 4 is a top plan view.

The ornamental design for a bottle, substantially as shown.
